Scrap Lumber (load first)	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	NO painted or stained wood. NO pressure-treated wood. Bulky Brush, Branches & Stumps	Stumps, logs and tree branches. Please cut into sections that are 4 feet long or less.	NO yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds or garden waste. NO commercial loads. Appliances & Scrap Metal	Large appliances (ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, clothes washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers), barbecues, metal sinks, gas-powered equipment and other metal items.	NO car bodies, trailers or greasy metal. NO propane tanks.	Please drain and recycle all liquids. Accepted items must be mostly metal.	Search database* for local “Appliance” or “Metal” recyclers.
Mattresses	Mattresses and box springs, any size.	NO commercial loads. NO furniture or frames.	Mattresses must be clean and dry. Mattresses cannot have bedbugs or major stains.	A Plus Removal & Recycling , 1302 W Main St #25, Auburn, 253.737.4441
Rigid Plastic	#1, 2, 4 and 5 plastics only: Plastic nursery pots, flower pots, buckets, children’s plastic toys and other rigid plastics.	NO VHS tapes, tarps, hoses, rubber, fiberglass, coolers, clamshells or dirty items.	Remove any metal or rubber parts before recycling.	
Tires	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Rims OK. Steel-belted and studded tires accepted.	NO commercial loads or large/heavy tractor/truck tires.	Limit 10 tires per vehicle.	Search database* for local “Tire” recyclers.
Confidential Documents	Sensitive/confidential documents for shredding. 2 banker boxes or 3 grocery bags per vehicle.	NO commercial quantities.	NO stiff metal, plastic bags or CDs/DVDs. Material is shredded on-site.	Free Community Shred Events: atg.wa.gov/shredathon.aspx , 800.551.4636
Electronics	CD/DVD players, VCRs, printers, scanners, keyboards, phones, radios and other electronics.	NO commercial equipment or large printers. Cardboard	Clean, dry, flattened cardboard.	NO wet or excessively dirty cardboard. NO strapping, packing material or garbage.	Please flatten cardboard.	Search database* for local “Cardboard” recyclers.
Styrofoam Blocks & Packing Peanuts	Clean, white Styrofoam blocks and packing peanuts of all colors.	NO urethane foam cushions, expanded polypropylene, foam insulation or used hot tub covers. - Do **NOT** bring **GARBAGE, CARPET OR PAINTED/LAMINATED WOOD**—put in your curbside garbage or take to a **King County Transfer Station**, 206.477.4466 kingcounty.gov/solidwaste • **Algona Transfer Station**: 35315 W Valley Hwy, Algona • **Bow Lake Transfer Station**: 18800 Orillia Rd S, Tukwila
- Do **NOT** bring **LATEX PAINT** to recycling events or Wastemobile—please dry out, discard lid and place in trash.
Helpful hint: Mix latex paint with kitty litter, shredded paper, saw dust or paint hardener to solidify it.
- Do **NOT** bring **OIL, GAS PRODUCTS, OIL-BASED PAINT, PESTICIDES OR HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS**—take to Auburn Hazardous Wastemobile.**
