Recycling your unwanted fluorescent tubes, CFLs and HIDs has never been easier!

Simply drop off burnt-out lights at one of over 150 collection sites across WA. We accept unlimited screw-base compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs), up to 15 pin-based or linear fluorescent lamps, and up to 2 high-intensity discharge (HID) lamps per day free of charge. Why Recycle?

Fluorescent and HID lights contain mercury, a toxic heavy metal and are illegal to throw out with regular garbage. Do your part to protect human health and the environment by recycling these lights properly.

Fluorescent Tubes (all shapes), Compact Fluorescent Lights (CFLs) and High Intensity Discharge (HIDs) Lights



NOT Accepted Products







Light Emitting Diode (LED), Incandescent, Halogen, and any other lights that do NOT contain mercury.

LightRecycle Washington is funded by an Environmental Handling Charge (EHC). An EHC of \$0.95 per light is added to all mercury-containing lights sold at retail in Washington State.
